

Autobiographical Video Reflection

In our Autobiographical video project, I talked the most about flying and its influence on me. I chose this subject, as it is very important in my life. I created my titles in LiveType, and it made the titles livelier. I created this video in Final Cut Pro, after filming myself in front of the green screen. After I imported my video, I cut it using the razor blade tool. Once I got the cut I wanted, I put in my green screen picture on the other video layer. I then inserted my B-Roll over certain parts, and then imported my LiveType title. After I got the main video and audio tweaked, I was able to work on the slideshow. I imported images and videos about me, and the song "So Far Away" by Staind. I then turned down the audio levels so that I wouldn't peak in the red. After everything was done, I put in end credits, exported it to a 1.5GB file, compressed it to 11.5MB, and then put it on my Digital Portfolio. I encountered problems when trying to edit my audio, as it would either be too soft or peak in the red. After a couple of days of tweaking with it I was able to get it to work. My favorite part of the video was doing work with the green screen and changing it to my liking. I didn't like having to render every time I made a change! I learned that videos are high sized files, as my 8 minute one came into 1.5GB uncompressed!!! I learned that I really like flying and that I am obsessed with US Airways.
